 - Katherine Webster reminded all of the upcoming "Taste of South Beach / Mission Bay" event along the South Beach Harbor (Pier 40 to AT&T Park) on Saturday Sept 25th from Noon to 6pm.
 - Katy Liddell reminded all of the upcoming NA-sponsored District 6 Supervisor Candidate Forum on Monday Sept 13th at UCSF Mission Bay's Genentech Hall from 6pm to 7:30pm. The 5 top-funded candidates have been invited: Jane Kim, Jim Meko, Theresa Sparks, Debra Walker, and Elaine Zamora
- **AMERICA'S CUP**
 - Kyri McClennan from City Hall and the Project Manager of Economic Development spoke about San Francisco's bid to host the 2014 America's Cup (the 'Super Bowl' of sailing). While Spain and Italy are also being considered, SF is the preferred host. The actual sailing events would be held in the northern waterfront, but Seawall Lot 330 (behind AT&T Park) and Piers 30/32 are being considered for the central public engagement hub - gathering space for media, VIPs, etc. Additional waterfront areas from Piers 48 to 80 are also being looked at for additional events. Short term renovations would be done for the America's Cup event, with long term usage to be revisited later. Final decision would be made in Sept 2010. Norman Pierce, long time South Beach resident and CAC member, spoke about the history of America's Cup. Followed by Q&A.
