- **SFPD SOUTHERN STATION CAPTAIN DANIEL McDONAGH**
 - Capt. McDonagh spoke briefly about overall crime in SF (violent crime down 14%); crime in the Southern District is also going down, tends to be 'quality of life' crimes (auto boost, break-ins, assaults). Sgt. Lisa Frazer, the Day Watch Commander, also spoke briefly. Followed by Q&A.

- **PATROL SPECIAL POLICE**
