- **WELCOME / INTRODUCTIONS (Katy Liddell)**
- **ANNOUNCEMENTS**
 - Katy announced that in lieu of a regular meeting for December, we will repeat last year's Holiday Social at South Beach Cafe. Details to be confirmed.
 - Jamie and Gary announced that the NEN Award winners were selected. They include Robert Finnell (Best Graffiti Watch Volunteer) and Jim Meko (Lifetime Achievement). NEN Awards to be held Nov 17th at City Hall.
 - Gary advised that another NERT training has been scheduled for South Beach. Every Tuesday evening from Feb 1st thru March 8th at the SFFD Headquarters (2nd/Townsend Streets). Flyer/formal announcement to be sent after Jan 1st.
- **TRAFFIC CALMING FOLLOW-UP**
 - Mike Sallaberry from the SFMTA and Lt. Bob O'Keefe of the CHP returned as a follow up to our June meeting on Traffic Calming. Based on the petition we submitted, Mike advised that the speed limit on King Street/The Embarcadero will be reduced from 35 to 30mph and that all pedestrian crossings in our neighborhood will be reviewed and evaluated. - **HEALTH EFFECTS OF CONGESTION PRICING**
 - Megan Wier and Jenny McLaughlin of the SF Dept of Public Health reviewed the study that has been done on the health effects of transportation and land use planning in SF. The study shows how noise and air pollution affect our health and studies how people travel within SF (car, public transportation, bike, walking) and how this impacts the environment in which we live, work, play.
