<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ <b>WELCOME (Katy Liddell)</b></li><li>▪ <b>ANNOUNCEMENTS</b><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>➤ Mike Anthony spoke about our NA Social Committee. He is actively looking for committee members to join him in planning upcoming events. A sign-up roster was passed around.</li><li>➤ Gary Pegueros reminded all that our April Citywide NERT Drill is Saturday 16<sup>th</sup>. Thursday April 28<sup>th</sup> at 10am, Port Commission Room (2<sup>nd</sup> Floor of the SF Ferry Bldg).</li></ul></li><li>▪ <b>CENTRAL CORRIDOR PROJECT</b><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>➤ Steve Wertheim of the SF Planning Dept gave a presentation on the Central Corridor Project which ties into the Central Subway project that will run up 4<sup>th</sup> Street from Caltrain and ending in Chinatown. The area is roughly bordered by Market to Townsend / 2<sup>nd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> Streets. This project looks at land use, design guidelines, bldg heights, and the street scene to determine what is needed, what the challenges are, and the best way to integrate public transportation and land use.
