- **PRESENTATION BY BOB BECK**
 - Bob Beck and Emilio Cruz of the Transbay Joint Powers Authority showed a very impressive video and gave an informative presentation on the new Transbay Transit Center, the Caltrain extension from 4th/King to the Center, and the California High-Speed Rail. The Transit Center is projected to open in 2018. Followed by Q & A.
- **PRESENTATION BY DAVID BEAUPRE**
 - David Beaupre, Project Manager for the Blue Greenway Project, gave an informative presentation on the Blue Greenway, a 500-mile, 9-county region wide Bay Trail. San Francisco's portion runs from Mission Creek south along the waterfront to the SF county line near Candlestick Point. Followed by Q & A.
