- **WELCOME / INTRODUCTIONS (Katy Liddell)**
 - Katy introduced all the Officers/Directors present including new Director Michael Anthony (who replaces Phil Hwee)

- **A CONVERSATION WITH RACHEL GORDON**
 - Alice Rogers introduced tonight's special guest speaker from the SF Chronicle, Rachel Gordon. Rachel has been covering City Hall since 1989 so she is well aware of the history and relationships among the Mayor, City Supervisors, and other staff. With District 6 Supervisor Chris Daly reaching his term limit, all eyes are on the race for his replacement. Aside from being one of the largest districts in SF, we also have the highest (South Beach/Rincon Hill/Mission Bay) and the lowest (Tenderloin) with regards to income base. Rachel spoke of some of the other District races and touched on such topics as Muni (things are going to get worse), the SF Chronicle (newspapers are dying, but SFC is still here ... barely), the upcoming Mayor's race, and new development planned for Treasure Island.

- **TRAFFIC CALMING**
 - Gary Pegueros spoke briefly about the need for add'l speed limit signage along King Street/The Embarcadero between Hwy 280/5th Street and the Ferry Bldg. He presented a petition for signatures. Corinne Woods also took a copy of the petition for the upcoming Mission Bay CAC meeting. Katy had spoken with a resident who is also interested in addressing this matter, so a 3rd petition was given to her.
