2011 Road Repaving & Street Safety Bond

Ed Reskin of the DPW gave an overview of the proposed \$248M Road Repaving & Street Safety Bond that will appear on the Nov ballot. The bond will repave streets throughout SF, seismically strengthen and repair deteriorating bridges, overpasses, and stairways, and make other traffic, pedestrian, and bike and safety improvements.
