We have a Social Committee that organizes group trips to Giants games and "Opera in the Park", walking tours, and numerous other social events to appease every appetite.

The most important thing about our group is that we all truly care about our neighborhood and we are willing to work to keep it good and make it better. We hope you will join us too in this mission.
