- **WELCOME/INTRODUCTIONS (Katy Liddell)**
- **ANNOUNCEMENTS**
 - Gary Pegueros advised of various e-newsletters available where interested residents can subscribe to receive regular updates from Supervisor Jane Kim, SFPD Southern District Captain Charlie Orkes, Ken Craig's "Community Patrol Crime Activity Report", Jamie Whitaker's Rincon Hill blog, and the Barbary Coast NA.
 - Gary provided an update on the MTA's announcement of analyzing all pedestrian crossings along the King Street / Embarcadero corridor. Originally scheduled to complete by Dec 2011, MTA advises the project is more extensive than anticipated and they hope to complete by Spring 2012. Gary also asked the MTA to review closely the intersections at the Caltrain station (4th/King, 4th/Towsend) as they will get more congested with further Mission Bay developments as well as the Central Subway System.
 - Gary updated on a few new businesses on Brannan Street, formerly empty commercial spaces. With regards to emergency readiness, South Beach will host another NERT training in early 2012 at the SFFD Headquarters. Flyer for this training will be distributed in Dec; training begins Tuesday January 17th. Other emergency readiness news from The Ferry Bldg: Upcoming renovations to include a Homeland Security 'disaster communications' system with audio and visual updates in multiple languages during an emergency. Also, the Water Emergency Transportation Authority will add add'l ferry service to help with evacuations during an emergency.
 - Jamie Whitaker provided a brief update on the Rincon Hill Dog Park. Electrical work to be completed early December. A Grand Opening event, date TBD, is being organized. Funding needs to be raised to pay for the lease.
- **A CONVERSATION WITH D6 SUPERVISOR JANE KIM**
 - Jane Kim addressed a list of questions and topics, many of which had been submitted to her office in advance after polling our residents. She addressed such topics as America's Cup, the electrification of Caltrain, a future school in Mission Bay, empty storefronts, Pier 38, pedestrian safety, and the Clear Channel kiosks.
