- **WELCOME / INTRODUCTIONS (Katy Liddell)**
- **A CONVERSATION WITH SFPD CHIEF GREG SUHR**
 - Greg Suhr, born and raised in SF, is a 30-year veteran of the SFPD. He was appointed Chief of Police by Mayor Ed Lee in April 2011. The group discussed various topics, with the main concerns being homelessness and coverage during Giants games. The Southern District Police Dept is the biggest and busiest station. Currently the dept is down 275 officers (soon to be 350 down), with the next police academy graduating December 2013. Chief Suhr emphasized the importance of reporting any/all crimes. - **WARRIORS ARENA SURVEY RESULTS**
 - In response to previous meetings and NA Yahoo Group emails concerning the proposed Warriors Arena at Piers 30-32, the NA Board decided to create and distribute a survey to get a reading of how our residents felt about this project. The survey was sent out on 8/31 and closed on 9/9. There were 741 respondents. 48.8% were strongly/somewhat AGAINST; 44.8% were strongly/somewhat FOR; 6.3% had no opinion/did not have enough information.
