# • GILLIAN GILLETT / CALTRAIN ELECTRIFICATION

➢ Gillian Gillett, Director of Transportation Policy – Office of the Mayor spoke about the Caltrain Electrification Project where trains will be switching from diesel to electric. This will result in more frequent trains during peak hours by 2019. The project is still many years away as it is not fully funded. A public scoping meeting is scheduled for Thursday March 7<sup>th</sup> from 6p-8p at SF City Hall, Board of Supervisors Chambers. Followed by Q&A.

#### GREG RIESSEN / HWY 280

Greg Riessen of the SF Planning Dept gave a presentation on the Hwy 280 project: existing conditions and options for traffic flow and what routes the new High Speed Rail can take to get into the city and reach the Transbay Transit Center. The leading proposal is to remove a portion of Hwy 280, making Mariposa the last exit. This would result in a large boulevard that would connect to King St. Followed by Q&A.
