• SWL330, Piers 30/32, Proposed Lucas Museum on SWL330

- Diane Oshima, Brad Benson, & Phil Williamson of the Port; Adam Van de Water of OEWD, Presenters
- Adam Van de Water explained that Mayor Lee has sent a letter to George Lucas
 offering SWL330 as a location for his Cultural Arts Museum. We are waiting for an
 answer. It is possible that, if Lucas accepts, that he could help with refurbishing
 Piers 30/32 to a small extent. However, none of this is real at this point.
- Non-profits (such as a museum) are not subject to tax. Therefore, a potential Lucas museum would not be paying taxes.
- One resident commented that she thought a museum would be a stand-alone on the Embarcadero. Another resident sees it as "a part of a cultural string" along the Embarcadero, citing the Exploratorium, Ferry Building, Photography Museum, etc.
- Another resident expressed worries about the museum making the neighborhood more like a Pier 39 with a Star Wars emphasis. On the other hand, another resident pointed out that Lucas has done everything in the Presidio quite tastefully and does not see a problem.
- If SWL330 is sold, State Lands Commission (SLC) would most likely require an updated appraisal. SWL330 was last appraised two or three years ago at \$30M. Development would be subject to CEQA.
- Brad Benson advised us that the Brannan Street Wharf was very expensive. It cost \$6M to demo Pier 36 and \$20M to build the new wharf. The Port does not have the money to do the same at Piers 30/32.
- Use of the Brannan Street Wharf (BSW) was questioned. One resident thinks it gets little use while another sees it getting quite a bit of use. Days / Times cited were different. It was suggested that a survey be done of users of Sue Bierman Park.
- The group agreed as a whole that we would welcome George Lucas' museum, and we will write a letter of support and invitation asap.
