A Conversation with D6 Supervisor Jane Kim

- **WELCOME / INTRODUCTIONS (Katy Liddell)**
- **ANNOUNCEMENTS**
 - Robert Mansfield, Chair of our NA Nominating Committee, spoke about our upcoming NA Elections (in March), with more details to follow. Anyone interested in getting more involved and perhaps running for one of the three seats is encouraged to participate.
 - Katy advised that our Feb meeting will focus on Homeless Encampments, with guest speakers Brenda Meskan (Interim Director, SFHOT) and Bevan Dufty (Director, HOPE).
 - The next Monthly Community Meeting with our SFPD Southern Station Captain is Wednesday 2/18. South Beach Harbor Community Room. 6:30p. Capt Roualdes is retiring. We will have an interim Capt until a permanent one is assigned.
 - The Police Dept is realigning its boundaries. A community meeting is scheduled for 2/25 at the Hall of Justice – 850 Bryant Street, room 551. 6pm.
 - Jeffrey Leibovitz and Alice Rogers reminded all of the 1/21 South Park Renovation fundraising event at 2 Jack London Street/Bryant. 6p to 8p.
 - Bruce Agid advised all that the Muni E-Line will begin weekend service July 2015, with full time service beginning early 2016.
 - The SB Democratic Club is holding a social at SB40 aka Carmen's (Pier 38) on 1/28 from 7p to 9p.
 - Corinne advised that the Muni #22 (switching #'s to 55) to run on 16th Street from the Bart station to 3rd Street will begin service by end of the month.
 - Patrick advised that the Merchant's Assoc. meets the 3rd Tuesday, monthly, at The Brick House, 9:30. The next meeting will feature Fran Weld introducing the Giants' pop-up—The Yard—opening in March.
- **A CONVERSATION WITH JANE KIM**
 - Jane advised that District 6 covers SoMa, Treasure Island, and Tenderloin. She has three aides. April covers Land Use and Planning. Sunny covers various topics such as schools, pedestrian safety, transportation, small business, and entertainment. Ivy (not present at tonight's meeting) covers homelessness and public safety. Jane distributed a list of their 'accomplishments' since taking office in 2011. Their three main goals have been to make San Francisco healthier, safer, and stronger.
