**Carmen Chu, San Francisco Assessor-Recorder**

Carmen's office is the city's public record keeper (deeds, marriage licenses, property taxes for both residential and business, etc). San Francisco has over \$200 Billion in assessed property value. Since taking office, Carmen has prioritized customer service and office efficiency, including digitizing historic real property records currently maintained only in hard copy. Previously, Carmen served as Supervisor for the Sunset / Parkside District and worked in the Mayor's Office of Public Policy and Finance. Followed by Q&A.

**Scoot - Electric Mopeds and Motorbikes**

Eli Saddler, Head of Network Operations and Public Affairs, talked about their network of electric scooters that you can pick up and drop off all over San Francisco - similar to the Bike Share Program. They have a fleet of approximately 500 scooters that can be parked in 60 participating garages + street parking. First time users can take an in-person class and view an online video instruction.
