**Bay Area Air Quality Management District – Climate Change and Air Quality**

Dave Vintze, Air Quality Planning Manager for BAAQMD, presented the 2017 Clean Air Plan, a comprehensive strategy to reduce ozone and fine particles throughout the region, reduce air toxics, and reduce Greenhouse Gas emissions. This plan impacts the 9 bay area counties in its aggressive action to eliminate fossil fuel combustion and transition to a post-carbon economy. In its goals to protect public health and protect the climate, the plan lays the groundwork for a long-term effort to reduce Bay Area Greenhouse Gas emissions 40% below 1990 levels by 2030 and 80% below 1990 levels by 2050.

**East Cut Community Benefit District**

Tom Kolbeck, Director of Operations and Community of the East Cut CBD, and Andrew Robinson, Executive Director of the East Cut CBD, gave a presentation on this newest CBD in San Francisco. (Other CBDs in San Francisco include Civic Center, Union Square, Tenderloin, Yerba Buena, and the Mission.) The East Cut CBD includes the Rincon Hill and Transbay neighborhoods.

Like other CBD's, neighborhood residents and business owners are levied a special assessment to fund improvements to the neighborhood. James, East Cut CBD's Operations Manager, spoke about some of the improvements including graffiti removal, homeless outreach, garbage removal, safety and security issues, and maintenance of five open space parks. Officer Scott Hart of Patrol Special and Brandon Davis of Downtown Streets Team, also spoke briefly about their collaborations with the East Cut CBD.

Several residents in attendance voiced their appreciation for the work being done by the CBD but were vehemently opposed to the name "East Cut".
