- **WELCOME + INTRODUCTIONS** (Alice Rogers)
 - This is our first hybrid meeting: In-person at Cloudflare (101 Townsend Street at 2nd Street) and Zoom. (Our first in-person meeting in 3 years.)
- **A Conversation with District 6 Supervisor Matt Dorsey**
 Supervisor Dorsey began with a brief history of his previous roles in San Francisco and his path to become a Supervisor. Recovery from drug addiction is a top issue. Fentanyl has exacerbated the situation. Police Staffing is another concern. Recruiting numbers are low. And many veteran officers are retiring. We need to match other cities in hiring incentives/bonuses.
