- **A Presentation of the Grand Embarcadero vision**  
Stacey Randecker, a resident of Potrero Hill for over 20 years, is one of many volunteers at Grand Embarcadero who has a vision of what our Embarcadero can be – a safer space for pedestrians, a destination to enjoy every day all day, with little to no cars passing thru. Think of Las Ramblas in Barcelona, or the River Walk of San Antonio. By taking away cars, you open up the space to more dining options, businesses, and open space/parks. We need to improve our public transportation and take advantage of low-emission vehicles to help fight climate change. We should push towards alternate forms of transportation such as electric ferries, electric or cargo bikes. Businesses should use better ways of moving goods to help fight climate change like moving goods on boats vs surface trucks.
