	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ <b>WELCOME &amp; INTRODUCTIONS (Katy Liddell)</b></li><li>▪ <b>PRESENTATION BY SFMTA ON THE CENTRAL SUBWAY SYSTEM</b><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>➤ Brajah Norris and Betty Chau from the SF MTA (Municipal Transportation Agency) discussed and reviewed the new Central Subway System, a new metro line from 4<sup>th</sup>/King Streets to Chinatown. Estimated to complete in 2018, the total cost is \$1.57 billion. Stations will be at 4<sup>th</sup>/King, 4<sup>th</sup>/Brannan, 4<sup>th</sup>/Folsom, Union Square, and Chinatown.
