Its purpose is to cultivate a community via events, workshops, and social activities. The initial location is 4<sup>th</sup> Street between Mission Bay Blvd N and Mission Bay Blvd S. Planters/troughs would be on pallets, able to be moved via a forklift if needed. As Mission Bay continues to develop, this garden might change locations depending on land use and development. \$200 per year membership fee covers all the general maintenance of the garden and planned activities. Followed by Q&amp;A.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>KEN NGAN / JEANNETTE SANCHEZ / MUNI METRO TURNBACK PROJECT</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Ken Ngan and Jeannette Sanchez reviewed the upcoming project slated for this year to replace existing metro rail as well as perform needed maintenance repairs and clean up in the underground portion between Embarcadero and Folsom Street Metro stops. Project must be completed by November, so project will be spread out over 5 weekends (midnight Friday to midnight Sunday) between now and then. Will not interfere with Giants games. Bus Bridge service to be provided when metro is down. Cost of project is \$3.6 million. Two community meetings are scheduled for May 2<sup>nd</sup> (Mission Creek Park Pavilion 5:30p to 6:30p) and May 8<sup>th</sup> (Bayview Library 6p to 7p).
