Meeting Minutes: Monday, September 11, 2017**

A Conversation with Captain Daryl Fong, SFPD Southern Station

NA Secretary Gary Pegueros facilitated tonight's meeting featuring Captain Fong who was joined by Andy Thornley from SFMTA and Randy Quezada from the SF Department of Homelessness and Supportive Housing.

The Captain began with an overview of crime and activity in the Southern district. Upcoming large scale events include the Folsom Street Fair, Oktoberfest at Pier 48, Oracle Open World events at Moscone Center and AT&T Park, Salesforce events at Moscone and AT&T Park, and Fleet Week. Regarding staffing, Police Chief William Scott regards foot beats as a priority. The number of foot beat patrol officers in the Southern District has grown since last year from 'none' to four, then eight, and now 13. Most are assigned to the areas around Moscone Center, Yerba Buena Gardens, and behind the Westfield Mall near Target.

The NA Yahoo Group was asked to submit questions to Captain Fong in advance. The pre-submitted questions dealt with noise pollution, bad behavior by car drivers, homeless and bike theft. Captain Fong, Andy, and Randy addressed each question.

Followed by additional Q&A from the floor.

Captain Fong holds monthly Community Meetings that rotate meeting locations around the Southern District. These meetings are a great opportunity to speak with the Captain and other city agency representatives about various issues and concerns. All meetings are from 6p to 7:30pm.
