Supervisor Dorsey was appointed to District 6 Supervisor three months ago. Previously he worked in San Francisco City Attorney's office for 14 years as Communications Director, and for 2+ years for the San Francisco Police Department as a Civilian Command Staff Director under Chief Bill Scott.

Some of the issues that concern Supervisor Dorsey:

- o Crisis of overdose deaths due to drugs
- o Getting more addicts into Treatment Centers
- o The need for more Housing, including affordable and supportive units
- Public Safety (including criminal justice, pedestrian safety, and speed enforcement)
- Safety for the unhoused population (as well as housing)
