- **WELCOME + INTRODUCTIONS** (Alice Rogers)
- **Presentation by Rachel Alonso, City Administrator's Office**
Rachel is the Prop B Planning and Implementation Project Director. Rachel began by reviewing the **2020 Prop B that passed**, reviewing what remains in the Public Works Department, and what moves to the new Sanitation & Streets (SAS) Department. She reviewed the duties/responsibilities and organizational structure of each department. Two Oversight Committees were created, one for each department. She reviewed their responsibilities and how commissioners are selected. She also provided a timeline for when these changes would take place.

Rachel then reviewed the **new proposed 2022 Prop B** that will be on the November ballot. Among other things, eliminate the SAS department and return those duties back to the Public Works department. Rachel reviewed the discussions and reasons that lead to the new Prop B.
