- **Biking and Rolling Plan**
Casey Hildreth of SFMTA presented on behalf of the project team who could not attend this evening. This is the plan that has brought us the bike lanes, bike-shares, scooters, etc in all SF neighborhoods. The goal is to connect residents to nearby bike facilities, taking into consideration safety and easy access. There is an ongoing conversation with individual neighborhoods regarding residents' needs and feedback. The Mission Bay plan scenarios are focusing on access to the new school, opening in 2026. There is also a focus on equity-priority communities.

- **Update on SFMTA Embarcadero Enhancement Project**
SFMTA Project Manager Casey Hildreth, who last presented on this topic at our February 2024 meeting, returns for an update on the project based on public input. This has been a decade-long project studying the Embarcadero promenade and bikeways, pedestrian safety, taking into account cars on the road, loading, parking, etc. Over the years, some quick-build projects have been implemented as pilots. The plan is to extend a protected two-lane bayside bike lane south to Brannan Street. This includes assessing palm tree placement as the median is reduced and the protective planting buffer is added and eliminating the northbound left-turn lanes at Brannan and Folsom Streets. The bike lane fronting Piers 30/32 will be temporary as any new project approval on the piers will be responsible for building out the sidewalk/roadway improvements along the property.
