- **District 6 Supervisor Matt Dorsey**  
Supervisor Dorsey opened with a topic that is among his top priorities – addressing the 6<sup>th</sup> Street corridor of heavy and open-air drug use and drug sales. Dorsey is asking for immediate action and implementation of [Prop 36](#) and submitted an [LOI](#) (Letter of Inquiry) asking various SF Departments and Agencies to maximize the use of arrests and involuntary holds for drug-related lawlessness to end open-air drug scenes on the 6<sup>th</sup> Street corridor.
