San Francisco Railyards Project

Welcome and Introductions (Alice Rogers)

San Francisco Railyards Project

Kristen Hall, urban designer and city planner, joined us along with several representatives of project sponsor Prologis, to present on the San Francisco Railvards Project - the 20-acre site at Caltrain's 4th and King rail station and yards. (Prologis, a global logistics company headquartered at Pier 1, owns this 20acre site.) The proposed project, to be done in phases, plans to transform the existing station and rail yard into a world-class train station and create a mixeduse, transit-oriented development with jobs, housing, retail, and public and community spaces. Phase one envisions a redesigned station at the base of an 850-foot office tower at 4^{th} St., plus an additional tower at 7^{th} /Townsend. Then, once the TJPA Portal Project undergrounds rails that will extend Caltrain service (and ultimately high-speed rail) to the Transbay Terminal at Salesforce Tower, the long strip currently occupied by rails will allow above ground development to tie SoMa, Showplace Square and Mission Bay.
