Alice advised that our next NA Elections will be in March. Gary, Bruce, and Mike will run again for their seats (each a 2-year term). If anyone is interested in throwing their hat in the ring, please let Alice know.
- **A conversation with District 6 Supervisor Matt Dorsey**
District 6 Supervisor Matt Dorsey began by stating he is more optimistic about where we are and where we are going as a city. But he also has some concerns about what is happening on a federal level – especially with the drug policy. The cutting of Medicaid funding will be very problematic for local governments. This is a real priority for him. Supervisor Dorsey and Mayor Lurie have aligned public safety priorities. Dorsey spoke highly of Mayor Lurie and his staff. Police Staffing is another priority. Dorsey spoke of a large developer and a large educational institution that are making a bet on San Francisco for their future. Both will have a huge positive impact on our economic vibrancy. Dorsey spoke about upcoming legislation on supportive housing for our residents with drug/substance abuse as well as the drug market and the 6th Street corridor.

Followed by Q&A.

Topics included SFPD Southern Station staffing and Police Redistricting, the proposed development at 329 Bryant Street (includes a 36-story bldg), the Amazon project, Dorsey’s top priorities for Mission Bay (the Mission Bay School and traffic safety, the Mission Bay TIF, and police staffing), Congestion Pricing, AI sustainability and growth, and police reform.
