- **Welcome and Introductions** (Alice Rogers)

- **A presentation on the Mission Bay Hub**

Erik Rice, Program Director of SFUSD, presented on the Mission Bay Hub which offers a year-long STEM-focused (**S**cience, **T**echnology, **E**ngineering, **M**athematics) program for 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade students in SFUSD. For the past two years, this program has been piloted at the UCSF campus. Both Kaiser and The Warriors have been terrific partners offering different events and classes. Industry experts come into the classroom for classes and presentations. There have been off-site classes at local sites like Genentech and SF General Hospital. The soon-to-open Mission Bay School will house this program on the 4<sup>th</sup> floor. Selected students from various SF high schools will spend a few hours of each school day at the Hub for intensive classes, then return to their school for the rest of their classes. The program offers a morning session and an afternoon session, with the designated schools assigned to one of the sessions. This is a rigorous English-intensive program with lots of reading, writing, and science offering real world application and preparing them for college. Erik reviewed the two pathways the students can take – either a Biotechnology theme or Patient-Care theme. Either pathway offers two teachers who lead these classes. Erik also reviewed the logistics of getting students to/from class, as well as a sneak peak of the Hub layout at the new Mission Bay School site. **A PDF of Erik’s slide deck presentation is attached or available upon request.**
