- Form a local Neighborhood Emergency Response Team (NERT). Since 2006, we have recruited approximately 50 new participants per year to take this FREE training.
- Provide a forum for candidates seeking election in our district, including producing D6 Supervisor Candidates Debates and Mayoral Meet + Greet.
- Address pedestrian safety issues (with successful changes to several intersections).
- Partner with our local Southern Station Police Captains on numerous issues.
- Partner with the Mayor's Office of Neighborhood Services, our District Supervisor's Office, and the Neighborhood Empowerment Network.
- Organize three very successful block parties in 2004, 2006, and 2008. Revenue from the last two (approx \$10,000 each) went to non-profit organizations.
