- **A Conversation with SFPD Southern Station Captain Carla Hurley**
Captain Hurley joined the SF Police Department in 2005, has worked in various roles (street patrol, narcotics, investigations, the airport, etc) and became the Southern Station Captain in April. As challenging as this role is, come October the boundaries for Southern Station will expand to add the Market Street corridor, adding a projected 31,000 calls for service to the existing workload. The Captain spoke of police officer trainings and hirings, and how officers are assigned to the various stations. The SFPD Command Staff has made Southern Station its top priority. The Captain explained the difference between officers assigned to Southern Station vs officers assigned to Chase/Oracle and other events. The Captain proceeded to answer a variety of questions related to neighborhood issues and concerns, staffing levels, drones, traffic law enforcement and pedestrian safety, and more.
